

Graduate Grade Requirements

Academic requirements:

Applicants should provide evidence that they have achieved a qualification (or a combination of qualifications) that meets the following criteria:

- In a fire-related subject area
- At Level 3 or above
- Requiring at least 370 hours of learning time (at least 37 credits)

Examples of qualifications that meet the criteria include:

 IFE Level 3 Diploma in Fire Science and Fire Safety

A listing of approved qualifications by country can be found by referring to the <u>IFE Approved</u> <u>Qualifications Listing</u>

OR

Successful completion (including passing associated assessments) of an IFE Recognised Educational Programme for GIFireE

OR

Provision of a <u>Technical Report</u> that meets the standards set out of in the IFE guidance


Other requirements:

At least 3 years of experience of working in a fire-related role (at least 4 years for those applying via the Technical Report Route)

PLUS

Evidence of completion of at least 25 hours of relevant Continuing Professional Development (CPD) in the previous 12 months
